



Meini Prawf ac Amodau

Er mwyn derbyn nawdd o dan y cynllun, rhaid i fyfyrwyr ateb y gofynion hyn:

1. Dilyn pwnc/pynciau sy'n gysylltiedig â'r amgylchedd e.e. astudiaethau gwledig, rheolaeth amgylchedd, astudiaethau morol, amaethyddiaeth, daearyddiaeth, bioleg, daeareg, coedwigaeth, rheolaeth tir a chefn gwlad, cynllunio gwledig (gweler nodyn 1 isod).
2. Gwneud cais ffurfiol ysgrifenedig ar gyfer y nawdd. Dewisir y myfyrwyr llwyddiannus ar sail y cais ac fe allai'r broses ddewis gynnwys cyfweiliad.
3. Dilyn cyfran o'r cwrs trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg. Bydd hyn yn golygu
 - gwneud isafswm o 40 credyd ar gwrs gradd dros 3 blynedd
 - gwneud isafswm o 20 credyd ar gwrs ôl-radd
4. Dilyn cwrs amser llawn neu ran amser, a heb fod mewn swydd neu ar secondiad o swydd barhaol.
5. Derbyn lleoliad gwaith am gyfnod o 5 wythnos yn y sefydliad(au) priodol (4 wythnos os yn dilyn cwrs ôl-radd), ac ysgrifennu adroddiad i'r sefydliad yn dilyn y lleoliad (gweler nodyn 2 isod).
6. Mynychu seminarau a chynadleddau perthnasol i'r Cynllun AmNawdd.
7. Rhoi eu manylion cyswllt i'r sefydliad ar ddiwedd y cwrs, fel y gellir monitro eu trywydd yn dilyn y cyfnod noddi.

Nodiadau:

(1) Wrth ddewis myfyrwyr i gymryd rhan yn y cynllun, rhoddir blaenoriaeth i fyfyrwyr sydd â chymwysterau/profiad da yn y maes amgylcheddol neu wyddonol. Byddai profiad o waith gwirfoddol perthnasol hefyd yn fanteisiol iawn.

(2) Disgwylir i'r myfyriwr fanteisio ar bob cyfle i ddefnyddio'r Gymraeg yn ystod y cyfnod lleoliad gwaith.



Terms and Conditions

In order to be eligible for sponsorship under the scheme, the students are required to:

1. Follow a subject or subjects relevant to the environmental field e.g. rural studies, environmental management, marine studies, agriculture, geography, biology, geology, forestry, land and countryside management, rural planning (refer to note 1 below).
2. Make a formal written application for the sponsorship. The selection of students will be based on the application and the process may include an interview.
3. Follow a proportion of the course through the medium of Welsh. This means
 - Follow a minimum of 40 credits on 3 year degree course
 - Follow a minimum of 20 credits on post-graduate course
4. Follow a full time or part time course, and not be in employment or on a secondment from a permanent job.
5. Carry out a work placement for a period of 5 weeks with one of the agencies (4 weeks if following a post-graduate degree), and write a report to the agency following the placement (refer to note 2 below).
6. Attend seminars and conferences related to the AmNawdd Scheme.
7. Give their contact details to the agencies at the end of the course, so that we can monitor their careers following the sponsorship period.

Notes:

(1) When choosing students to take part in the scheme, preference will be given to students with good qualifications/experience in the environmental or scientific field. Experience of relevant voluntary work would also be of advantage

(2) The students are expected to take advantage of every opportunity to use their Welsh during the work placement period.
